# **Check Fraud**

Be careful about putting checks into your mailbox.
Fraudsters have adapted a popular mail scam using a technique called "check washing" to scam you out of your money. The U.S. Postal Inspection Service (USPIS) said scammers will steal signed checks from your mailbox and use chemicals to remove the dollar amount, then write over it to a larger dollar amount. They'll then wash away the recipient's name on the check and make it payable to a fake identity before cashing it.

### What can you do to protect yourself?

- Only drop checks into the blue secure mail pickup areas- try to avoiding mailing checks. If you still want to use checks, remember to use the blue mail boxes to add security.
- Pay your bills a different wayset up an automatic payment or ask your provider for different payment options.
- If you suspect possible mail fraud, please contact the local police.
